I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that I have entered the appropriate division and have all relevant qualifications. I accept all liability for entering the division as stated on this entry form.

I acknowledge that horse-related activities are inherently dangerous and expressly assume the risk associated with handling, caring for and riding horses on the show grounds. I assume all risks of engaging in horse-related activities on the show grounds. I further acknowledge the inherent risk in riding and working around horses, which risks include bodily injury to both horse and rider which can result from normal use, competition or schooling.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in this event, I hereby assume all risk and I hereby release and absolve the Organizing Committee, Hobbit Hollows Riding School, Farpoint Farms, Teresa and Julian Longsworth, Equine Canada and their officials, Horse Council B.C., volunteers, Officers, Directors, agents, representatives and employees, independent contractors and the owners and occupiers of the land upon which the competition is held from all responsibility, liability or claims of any nature and kind which may be arise from my participation in this activity, including but not limited to bodily injury or death to myself or my horse(s) and damage to property arising from any cause whatever, including the negligence of one or more of the individuals and organizations referred to herein.

All Riders must wear a certified, approved, properly fitted, ASTM/SEI approved helmet whenever mounted. All approved helmets must be fitted with a harness and fastened when jumping. It is understood that juniors not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete at this event.
